

# Earl V Anderson Obituary, 9/9/17



Earl V Anderson, 67, of Fielding, Utah, passed away suddenly due to an auto accident on Saturday, Sept. 9, 2017, at the Logan Regional Hospital. Born in Logan, Utah, to Madge and Verl Anderson on January 2, 1950. He lived his life running the family farm.
